Frequently Asked Questions

What are the benefits of spraying compared to mowing?

Spraying weeds can eliminate or control them in one application. Spraying is more economical and faster to apply. Spraying does not propagate spreading of the weeds and has a smaller impact on ground disturbance

How long will the effects of the herbicide last after it is applied?

The duration of the herbicides effectiveness is also determined by the type of herbicide applied. We offer products that will control vegetation for long and short durations.

Are the herbicides dangerous to the applicator?

With proper training and the implementation of our extensive safety measures our applicators exposure is limited to well within the safe range as deemed by the government of Alberta, reducing or eliminating the potential for any adverse health effects.
